We are delighted to announce that the 11th International Conference on Ultrahigh Intensity Lasers (ICUIL 2026) will be hosted by the UK's Central Laser Facility and held in the historic town of St Andrews on the east coast of Scotland, UK. Well known internationally as the home of golf and location of the Old Course, one of the oldest and most iconic golf courses in the world, St Andrews can trace its origins to medieval times, and the ruin of St Andrews Cathedral provides a dramatic skyline for the town.
